Distances shown are between Central Business Districts. See yellow band on chart for example.

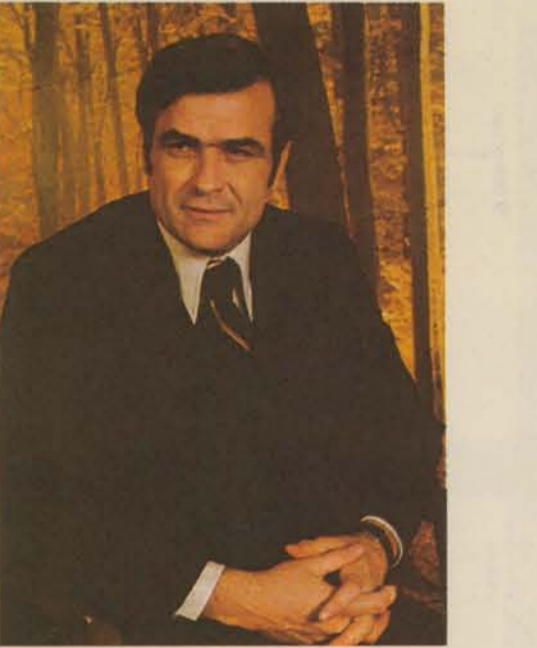
